NOTIFICATION
(CUSTOMS)

S.R.O 449 (I)/2011.- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 219 of the Customs Act, 1989 (IV of 1969), the Federal Board of Revenue is pleased to direct that the following further amendments shall be made in the Customs Rules, 2001, namely:-

In the aforesaid Rules, in Chapter VIII,

- (i) in rule 93,-
- (a) in sub-rule (1), for the colon a full stop shall be substituted and thereafter the following words, figure, brackets and colon shall be added, namely:-
- "Each applicant shall deposit a course fee of Rs.5000 in the respective account of the Directorate General of Training and Research (Customs) and its Regional Directorates;" ; and
- (b) in sub-rule (2), for the word 'marks', the words 'aggregate marks alongwith forty per cent marks in each of the three subjects' shall be substituted; and
- (ii) in rule 99, for the word 'two', the word 'five' shall be substituted and after full stop, at the end, the following shall be added, namely:-
- "A written test at the end of each six day mandatory course shall be conducted with a qualifying benchmark of at least forty per cent marks alongwith ninety per cent attendance during the course. The Customs Agent who does not fulfill these requirements shall repeat the course on re-payment of the prescribed course fee."
