Public Notice

It is hereby notified for all concerned that the Microclear based customs clearance system presently operating at Model Customs Collectorate of PaCCS Karachi shall cease to be operative w.e.f. 28.05.2010. The Importers, Exporters, Customs Agents, Terminal Operators, Shipping Agents and other stakeholders are hereby informed that the following shall be the steps / procedure for gradual termination of business before the closure comes into effect. The procedure is aimed at ensuring smooth transition and avoiding hardships to the stakeholders.

Manifest Filing:

Import manifests shall not be filed in PaCCS with immediate effect. The shipping agents are, therefore, requested to file manifests in One-Customs. All import cargo relating to these manifests, therefore, shall be cleared from the Collectorates working under One-Customs i.e. MCC of Appraisalment and MCC of Port Qasim.

G.D. filing:

No Goods Declaration shall be entertained in PaCCS system with immediate effect. The importers are therefore requested not to file their GDs in PaCCS system on and after 26.05.2010. (10-00 PM) The national Bank of Pakistan is notified not to accept any initial duty / taxes against fresh GDs regarding import / exports filed through MCC (PaCCS) Karachi w.e.f. 26.05.2010.(10-00PM) The additional duties / taxes against GDs filed prior to 26.05.2010 may continue to be accepted.

Export cargo:

No export cargo shall be allowed 'Gate-in' in PaCCS w.e.f. 27.05.2010.(After 2000 Hours) The exporters are advised to ensure that the entire shipment covered in their export G.D reaches the Export Gates of terminals well before the time mentioned above, for avoiding delays. The terminal operators are directed not to entertain any

shipment in PaCCS after the stipulated time. All export cargo shall be entertained by the MCC (Exports) Karachi after the above date and time. All stakeholders are advised to contact MCC Export for any information regarding clearance of export cargo after the stipulated date and time.

P.D. Account:

All P.D. Account holders are advised to file online refund for the balance of their PD Accounts by 27.05.2010.(2000 Hours)


New Customs computerized System:

The new Customs Computerized Clearance System shall be in place soon, initially for the selected importers and exporters, from a date to be notified by the Board.

Legacy Issues:

The MCC of PaCCS shall, through a standing order, prescribe a detailed procedure for dealing with the legacy issues relating to duty draw backs, refunds, adjudication, recoveries and other matters.
