It is pertinent to mention that according to the Customs Rules, 2001, <u>only the License Holder Agents (Proprietors/ Partners/ Directors)</u> and not their employees/ managers/ representatives in the subject course are entitled to attend course. Furthermore 90% attendance is mandatory for issuance of course completion certificate.
