<u>CROSS-STUFFING OF TRANSIT TRADE CONSIGNMENTS AT KPT DESIGNATED PREMISES</u>

Please refer to the subject cited above.

- It is informed that Board vide SRO 420(I)/2023 and SRO 421(I)/2023 both dated 31.03.2023, approved Karachi Port Trust (KPT) for cross-stuffing of cargo in transit to Afghanistan and Uzbekistan respectively. Subsequently, the required WeBOC connectivity for carrying out cross-stuffing of transit cargo moved from the main sea terminals to the designated approved places at KPT in East and West Wharves has been established for forward transit cargo of Uzbekistan only. Release Notes issued from the Directorate of Reforms & Automation, Karachi are enclosed for ready reference (Annex-A).
- 3. In view of foregoing, it is requested to ensure that all necessary arrangements are in place to facilitate the cross-stuffing activities of forward Uzbekistan transit cargo within the designated premises of KPT as per law without any hindrance.

- For Privileged Person (PP) GD, at the time of filing/submission of PP GD, the system now checks/validates if an exemption certificate is issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) user role: Certificate/NOC Document Issuance Authority against the NTN, BL Number, BL Date & VIR Number as mentioned in GD.
- The system now matches the following fields of GD with the MOFA exemption certificate:
 - Trader NTN
 - BL/AWB No
 - o BL Date
 - o VIR Number
- In case the exemption certificate against GD's NTN, BL Number, BL Date & VIR Number is not matched and found then the system displays a warning message:
 - "Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) Exemption Certificate is not found; GD shall not be released without a required certificate"
- For Privileged Person (PP) GD, it is required that before marking the GD for Gate Out step the system again checks/validates that if the exemption certificate is issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) user role: Certificate/NOC Document Issuance Authority against the NTN, BL Number, BL Date & VIR Number as mentioned in GD.
- In case the exemption certificate against GD's NTN, BL Number, BL Date & VIR Number is not found then:
 - The system holds the PP GD for marking forward to the next step/Gate out.
 - PP GD remains on hold till the issuance of the exemption certificate from MOFA.

- System updates the GD status as:
 - "GD Hold due to non-availability of MOFA certificate"
- In case the exemption certificate against GD's NTN, BL Number, BL Date & VIR Number is and matched in the system, then:
 - The System un-holds the PP GD and marks forward to the next step/GD Assigned to Gate Out Role.

- ❖ The auto waiver/exemption of Sindh Infrastructure CESS, which was implemented vide CRFs No. CRF-1295-21022020, CRF-1679-15022021, CRF-1769-20042021 & CRF-2696-04042023 on the undermentioned NTNs and PCTs have been revoked.
- By implementing the above requirement:
 - Auto-waiver/exemption functionality of Sindh CESS implemented for the undermentioned NTNs & PCTs is removed from the System.
 - Sindh Infrastructure CESS, where applicable are calculated and marked for payment by System against undermentioned NTNs and PCTs.
 - GDs of the undermentioned NTNs and PCTs are available Excise & Taxation Officer (ETO) role when marked for payment. The excise & Taxation Officer (ETO) role can exempt Sind CESS by using already developed and available functionality on a caseto-case basis.

Currently in the system, at the time vessel registration system is showing their Terminals against Port Codes. KPT West Wharf and KPT East Wharf are also showing against their Port Codes and are available for further BL filing process. The system is now showing KPT West Wharf and KPT East Wharf against SAPT due to the binding of KPT West Wharf and KPT East Wharf with SAPT.

- The "Shed/Terminal Location" of KPT West Wharf and KPT East Wharf is now available on the GD screen and KPT West Wharf and KPT East Wharf are now bound with SAPT.
- System is now showing KPT West Wharf and KPT East Wharf in Shed/Terminal Location dropdown as per mentioned because KPT West Wharf and KPT East Wharf are now bound with SAPT for cross stuffing
- The system is now bound with the KPT West Wharf and KPT East Wharf Shed/Terminal on the GD screen with Manifest/BL, so the SAPT, KPT West Wharf, and KPT East Wharf are also available on the GD screen for cross-stuffing and further processing.
- For binding KPT West Wharf and KPT East Wharf with SAPT for cross-stuffing, the system now also incorporates the following change.

Uzbekistan Forward Cargo:

❖ IGM Index / BL Filing:

- User selects "**Transit**" from the "**Index Type**" drop-down for Uzbekistan Transit Forward Cargo.
 - A. Transit is allowed where "Importer Country" is "Uzbekistan" &
 - B. The system shall show all cities of Uzbekistan (Importer Country) in the "Importer City" dropdown.
- Application allows selecting following terminals only from the "Via Port" drop-down in case of Transit Index type;
 - A. Torkham (In case of transit cargo through sea terminals)
 - B. Chaman (In case of transit cargo through sea terminals)
 - C. Off-Dock Terminals (In case of transit cargo through off-dock terminals). Only those Off-Dock terminals are displayed in the dropdown That is associated with the selected Port/Terminal where the vessel is berthed.
- If "Via Port" is selected "Off-Dock" Terminal, the system considers that stuffing is required and the 'Off-Dock" terminal and starts Inter Port Movement.
- A new functionality has been developed for Uzbek Trader/Agent in case of "Via Port"
 was selected as "Torkham/Chaman" to update Via port for off-dock for interpretmovement only for those cases which "Importer Country" is "Uzbekistan", Trader TIN
 is Uzbekistan user and BL is not claimed.
- Uzbek Trader/Agent can update the IGM Index/BL through the option "User Support System>>Amend Transit BL Via Port for Inter-port Movement".
- Trader/Agent clicks on "Amend Transit BL Via Port for Inter-port Movement" and gets
 the screen for searching VIR and BL.
- However, the System ensures that "Importer Country" is "Uzbekistan", Trader TIN is Uzbekistan user and BL is not claimed
- After searching the required BL, Trader/Agent clicks on the record to update the Via Port.

- Trader/Agent can see all details of BL. All fields are locked except the "Via Port" and "Remarks".
- Only those Off-Dock terminals are shown in the "Via Port" drop-down That is associated with the selected Port/Terminal where the vessel is berthed.
- o In the Case of Port Code: MCC Appraisement SAPT Karachi, the system now shows the KPT East Wharf and KPT West Wharf in the Via Port drop-down. The system now shows KPT East Wharf and KPT West Wharf in Via Port.
- Trader/Agent is now able to select KPT East Wharf and KPT West Wharf in the "Via Port" enter "Remarks" as mandatory fields and click on the "Update BL" button. After updating this information, the system updates the "Via Port" in the main manifest entered by the shipping company.
- Once the system updates the "Via Port" in the main manifest, the system starts Inter Port movement towards the "Off-Dock" terminal based on the selected "Off-Dock" terminal for cross-stuffing.
- o After Inter Port Movement started, now the system does not allow the Trader/Agent to update the BL information for changing the "Via Port".
- o Further inter-port flow shall work on an ASIS process basis.

- ❖ MOTOR SPIRIT, HSD, and JP-1 were being cleared in One-Customs as POL Products. One-Customs has been shut down on 31.03.2023 and the said goods are being declared for clearance in the WeBOC system. In this regard, M/s Pakistan State Oil has submitted a letter informing therein that the PCT of JP-1/JET FUEL (2710.1912) is not reflected in the WeBOC/Trader ID. So, they are unable to process the filing of the Goods Declaration in WeBOC.
- Currently in POL GDs system validates whether the PDL exists on the HS-Code or not. if it does, the quantity in liters is recorded in the Survey/NOC and the following GDS are filled against that NOC. otherwise, the system gives a validation alert "Petroleum levy not found against hs code"
 - o Into bond pol
 - o Ex-bond pol
 - Transfer advice import
- Application now allows bypassing of the validation against HS-Code 2710.1912 as the PDL rate does not exist in the PCT structure and by classification 2710.1912 falls under POL products. The system allows user to file POL product GDs without PDL rate against HS-Code 2710.1912
